Travel Medical Insurance for Non-U.S. Citizens Traveling to the U.S.

Plan Highlights

- Up to \$1,000,000 Medical Maximum per Period of Insurance | Emergency Medical Evacuation | Medically Necessary Repatriation | Political and Natural Disasters Evacuation | Repatriation of Mortal Remains or Local Burial | Emergency Reunion | Wellness Benefit
- This plan provides coverage to non-US citizens who reside outside the USA and are traveling outside of their Home Country to visit solely the US, or to visit a combination of the US and other countries. It is not available to anyone age 90 or above.
- This plan is not available to any individual who has been residing within the US for more than 365 days prior to their Effective Date
- Coverage for an Acute Onset of a Pre-Existing Condition
- Coverage from 5 days to a maximum of 364 days
- Optional Sports Activity coverage and Return to Home Country coverage available

Optional Sports Activity Coverage - If Chosen

If coverage is purchased this benefit provides coverage to the Covered Person while performing, practicing, or participating in archery, tennis, swimming, cross country, track, volleyball, golf, ballet, baseball, basketball, cheerleading, equestrian, fencing, gymnastics, polo, rowing, soccer, and softball. Any Collision Sport, Extreme Sport or Sport Activity not expressly covered hereunder is excluded from this coverage. Professional and Semi-Professional sports are never covered.

Optional Return to Home Country Coverage - If Chosen

If Coverage is purchased, the Covered Person may return to their Home Country for up to 60 days per 12 months of Coverage Purchased during the Period of Insurance for an Incidental Trip. If a Covered Injury or Sickness occurs while on their Incidental Trip, this benefit will pay to the maximum as outlined in the Schedule of Benefits for covered medical expenses incurred during the Incidental Trip. To be eligible for an Incidental Trip the Covered Person's Period of Insurance must be greater than 30 days in length. If the Covered Person does not return from their Incidental Trip on their scheduled return date, the Coverage will be Terminated on the date of their scheduled return from their Home Country. If the Covered Person's scheduled return date cannot be verified, the Coverage will terminate on the date the Covered Person departed for their Home Country. Any Injury or Sickness that occurred during the Incidental Trip will be considered a Pre-Existing Condition once the Incidental Trip has concluded and no further expenses for that Injury or Sickness will be covered.
